Each tank battery and/or other point of connection located in Andrews, Martin, Ector and Midland Counties, Texas at which Beta Crude Connector, LLC is physically able to receive Crude Petroleum into its System, all of which are identified on the Schedule of Receipt Points posted on Beta Crude Connector, LLC's website at <a href="http://www.frontierenergyllc.com">www.frontierenergyllc.com</a> , as such schedule may be amended from time to time	Centurion Pipeline L.P.'s Midland Tank Farm, Midland County, Texas	\$0.70

Note: All rates herein will be subject to the FERC Oil Pipeline Index.

**Handling, Pumping and Delivery:**

An additional charge of ten and twenty-nine one-hundredths cents (10.29¢) per barrel will be made for delivery of Crude Petroleum from the Midland Tank Farm, Midland County, Texas, to the meter for injection into Plains Basin Pipeline or Enterprise Pipeline or the Sunoco Midland Terminal. For scheduling purposes only, the shipper shall identify for Centurion Pipeline L.P. whether the intended destination for such volumes is the Plains Basin Pipeline or the Enterprise Pipeline or the Sunoco Midland Terminal. An additional charge of fifteen and six one-hundredths cents (15.06¢) per barrel will be made for delivery of Crude Petroleum from the Midland Tank Farm, Midland County, Texas, to Mesa Pipeline Midland Station.

**Joint Routing:**

1. Beta Crude Connector, LLC – From Receipt Points in Andrews, Martin, Ector and Midland Counties, Texas identified on its Schedule of Receipt Points to Centurion Pipeline L.P., Martin County, Texas
2. Centurion Pipeline L.P. – From Mabee Ranch Station, Martin County, Texas to Midland Tank Farm, Midland County, Texas

**Exceptions to Beta Crude Connector, LLC's Rules and Regulations:**

A total pipeline loss allowance ("PLA") of two-tenths of one percent (0.2%) will be deducted from the quantity of Crude Petroleum received to cover shrinkage and evaporation, interface losses, measurement inaccuracies and other normal losses that occur during the transportation of Crude Petroleum under this joint tariff.
